Sanjeev Bhargava, Creative Director of SEHER has been advising various agencies of the Govt. of India on Culture- directly working with several Cabinet Ministers and others for select occasions. He has served on the Central Advisory Board of Culture (CABC), Govt of India. Over the last decade SEHER has been instrumental in making Delhi the Cultural hub of the nation. SEHER has single-handedly changed the cultural profile of the Capital by establishing several thematic annual festivals in public spaces in Delhi – different monuments and parks having their own annual cultural festivals that form the Cultural calendar of Delhi and other cities. Festivals like the Udaipur World Music Festival, Jaipur Jazz and Blues Festival, Ananya Dance Festival at Purana Qila, Bhakti Utsav at Nehru Park, Qutub Festival at the majestic Qutub Minar, Gurbani Festival at the Talkatora Gardens, the SAARC Bands Festival at Central Park, ASEAN India Music Festival at Purana Qila and the Delhi Jazz Festival are now some of the most eagerly awaited annual events. Mr. Bhargava is also appointed as the Vice Chairman of Asia Pacific Music Meeting (APaMM) since 2018 by Ulsan Arts and Culture Foundation, South Korea.



Mr. Sanjeev Bhargava was presented the Order of Knighthood by the President of Italy with the Order of the Star for promoting friendly relations and cooperation between India and Italy in 2016.

Sanjeev Bhargava has also served as a Member of the National Tourism Advisory Council (NTAC) advising the Ministry of Tourism, Govt. of India on promoting and reinstating Brand India, through heritage and culture. He has also served on the Expert Committee of Ministry of Culture, GOI and has worked with the Ministry of External Affairs on specific projects like the 14th SAARC summit held in India in April 2007. Furthermore, he has served as a member of the Central Board of Film Certification (CBFC) of the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, Govt. of India for two consecutive terms from 2004 to 2011



SEHER organized a much appreciated cultural evening at the Prime Minister's dinner on the occasion of the SAARC Summit in 2007, when leaders of all the SAARC nations visited Delhi. Thereafter the flagship event of the SAARC CULTURAL FESTIVAL -- the SAARC Bands Festival was conceived, designed and implemented by us in November-December at the Central Park, Connaught Place. The occassion remains a landmark event for the Govt. of India till date. Since 2007, Delhi has seen seven, successful editions of the South Asian Bands Festival, at the Purana Qila.




The flagship event that SEHER conceptualized and organized - the Official Banquet for the President of India in November 2010 in honour of the President of United States of America H.E. Barack Obama and his entourage on their historic visit to India in 2010. Looking at the success of the previous one in January 2015 SEHER was selected once again to organize and plan the Cultural evening at the Rashtrapati Bhavan at the official banquet for President Obama's second trip again. Also in October 2011 Seher was yet again chosen exclusively by the Ministry of External Affairs to do the Indian Cultural Component at the Royal Wedding in Bhutan.

SEHER is also instrumental in organising important, official dinners of Ministries such as Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Commerce & Industry and the Ministry of Corporate Affairs. Large, important inaugurations for prestigious events of the Indian Government such as Indian Textile Shows at the ITPO and the International Film Festival in Goa have been conceptualized and implemented by SEHER. Recently, we also did the inaugural cultural presentation and the cultural programmeat the host country reception for the 4th Annual Meeting of Asian Development Bank. This was attended by delegates and governors of 66 countries and inaugurated by Hon'ble Prime Minister of India.

### UDAIPUR WORLD MUSIC FESTIVAL



**Udaipur World Music Festival**, first of its' kind annual destination festival of World Music, conceptualised and produced by SEHER every year in the month of February since 2016.

UWMF is an annual destination festival with more than 150 artists from over 15 different countries participating in this three day festival, and is attended by over 50,000 people over three days.

The film has been featured across 354 million full-time households and hotel rooms in more than 200 countries.




